- MEMBERSHIP YEAR - JANUARY 1ST THROUGH TO DECEMBER 31ST & IS NOT PRORATED
- MEMBERSHIP YEARS CAN NOT BE PRORATED.
- AGE IS CALCULATED AS OF DECEMBER 31ST IN THE YEAR OF MEMBERSHIP.
- COMPLETE SEPARATE FORM FOR EACH FAMILY MEMBER.
- MAKE ALL PAYMENTS PAYABLE TO NLAA.
- COMPLETE NEW APPLICATION FORM SHOULD ANY OF THE ABOVE INFORMATION CHANGE DURING THE YEAR

- Performances included in Provincial 5km and 10km road running rankings.
- General Liability Insurance.

DAY OF EVENT PERMIT FOR PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL ATHLETES DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR - \$1.00.

Applies only for NLAA sanctioned events which are organized for schools exclusively and school grades are used for determining the age categories. Affects non-members only.

SCHOOL - ASSOCIATE CLUB

During the school year, schools may join as associate clubs for \$25.00. Once the application is approved, students may compete under their school name in NLAA sanctioned events for the duration of the school year; all school students will then be exempted to pay \$1 Day of Event Permit. Continuing to compete in summer competitions and non-school designated meets, would require students to upgrade to a full competitive membership or purchase Day of Event Permit at \$5 fee.
